

TRAVEL & LOGISTICS INFORMATION

TO KING SALMON:

We **strongly recommend** that guests travel all the way to King Salmon, AK and overnight the day before your departure to camp.

Most major airlines fly to Anchorage. Currently Alaska Air and Ravn Air fly between Anchorage and King Salmon.

Once in King Salmon contact our charter company, Egli Air Haul, at (907) 246-3554 (or you may press #20 at the airport call terminal) to let them know you have arrived in King Salmon and to coordinate your shuttle to their hanger. **If you don't catch them on your arrival day, be sure and contact them NO LATER THAN 8:30 a.m. the next morning.**

For your overnight stay in King Salmon, call your lodging operator for shuttle service from the airport. Note, if you're up for it, Antlers Inn is a ~300 yard walk from the airport.

TO CAMP:

The next morning, usually between 9am and 10am, Egli Air Haul will shuttle your party to their hanger then transport you from King Salmon to the camp via helicopter. The flight duration is a ½ hour.

BRING SOFT-SIDED LUGGAGE:

Soft-sided luggage is mandatory. Two medium duffel bags (~70 to 75 liters each) is much better than one large bag. Do not over pack and do not bring large hard-sided roller bags, as the helicopter has VERY limited cargo space.

There is a strictly enforced **60 pound per person weight restriction** on luggage (including rods/reels, daypacks and any duffels). Yes, you can get everything within 60 pounds.

IMPORTANT NOTE: IF YOUR GROUP EXCEEDS OUR MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMIT FOR CHARTER FLIGHTS TO/FROM CAMP BECAUSE OF BODY OR BAGGAGE WEIGHT, THE GROUP WILL BE SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL CHARGES.

Please be prepared to be flexible in how the pilots arrange you and your gear flying to/from camp.

We suggest 250 pounds as a maximum guest weight limit. Please contact us for more details or if you have questions.

We prefer that guests avoid bringing large "bazooka-type" rod carries; 3 and 4 piece fly rods and 2 piece spinning rods travel best on the helicopter.

Travel logistics between our OUTPOST camp and King Salmon are much simpler compared to our SAFARI camp. Because of the helicopter transport to/from camp and camp's closer proximity to King Salmon, you are far less likely to experience weather delays (compared to the SAFARI camp). Therefore, under most conditions, you can expect to return to King Salmon on the last day of your trip with a high degree of confidence.

Note: There may be camp supplies and/or groceries flown in with you to camp.

DEPARTING KING SALMON:

Egli Air Haul will return for you the following Saturday. Your flight from King Salmon to Anchorage should depart **NO EARLIER THAN 3:00 p.m.** to allow for possible weather delays.

LEAVING PERSONAL ITEMS IN THE HANGER:

If you are traveling elsewhere in Alaska before or after your week at camp, you may leave those extra items in the Egli Air Haul hanger to lighten your load to/from camp. Be sure and coordinate with an Egli Air Haul employee.

LEAVE TRAVEL PLANS WITH SOMEONE:

Leave your flight itinerary, reservation/confirmation #'s and appropriate airline phone numbers with a family member in case you need to make changes to your schedule because of weather delays. We do have a satellite phone (sometimes limited connectivity) at the camp for situations like this, but it is often easier and more efficient to have a family make flight changes for you.
