\$4,250 7 days/6 nights (certain dates only) \$4,750 8 days/7 nights (certain dates only)

INCLUDED:

- Round-trip air charter from King Salmon to camp via helicopter
- Guided fishing for 5.5 or 6.5 days
- Rustic camp accommodations
- Meals
- Limited complimentary drinks
- Flies and terminal tackle

NOT INCLUDED:

- Transportation to King Salmon, AK
- Hotel in King Salmon or Anchorage
- Fishing license (\$45 for 7 day non-resident;
 \$45 for 7 day King Salmon stamp)
- Fishing rod/reel
- Gratuities

Guest tents include bedding (sleeping bag, bag liner, pillow & basic cot).

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION: A 50% deposit per person is required to secure your reservation. Payments are not refundable unless that space can be refilled, but they are transferable to another person within that season or to any open date within that season. Final payment is due 90 days prior to arrival. Travel insurance may be purchased through major carriers.

TRAVEL: Guests should travel to King Salmon, AK on the day before your trip and overnight. The next morning you fly to camp, then return to King Salmon the last day of your trip.

Remember to dress in layers — the conditions can change from rainy and windy to sunny and calm, and back, in the same afternoon.
