INCLUDED:

- Round-trip air charter from King Salmon to camp via helicopter and/or bush plane
- **0 days** helicopter fly-outs, **Mid season**
- **2 days** helicopter fly-outs, **Late season**
- Guided fishing for 6 to 6.5 days
- Deluxe camp accommodations
- Meals
- Limited complimentary drinks
- Flies, lures and terminal tackle

NOT INCLUDED:

- Transportation to King Salmon, AK
- Hotel in King Salmon or Anchorage
- Fishing license (\$45 for 7 day non-resident)
- Fishing equipment (available upon request)
- Gratuities

Sleeping shelters include bedding, gear storage box, clothes hangers, sitting chair, night stand and reading light.

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION: A 50% deposit per person is required to secure your reservation. Payments are not refundable unless that space can be refilled, but they are transferable to another person within that season or to any open date within that season. Final payment is due 60 days prior to arrival. Travel insurance may be purchased through major carriers.

TRAVEL: Guests should travel to King Salmon on Friday and overnight. Saturday a.m. you will fly to camp, then return to King Salmon the following Saturday afternoon.

Remember to dress in layers – the conditions can change from rainy and windy to sunny and calm, and back, in the same afternoon.
